You'll immediately appreciate the light and space created by the dual-aspect open-plan kitchen/living area. Large windows bring in daylight from two sides, showcasing the engineered parquet flooring and neutral palette. There's plenty of room to relax and work, while the smartly designed kitchen sits neatly to one side, fitted with sleek units, integrated appliances and stylish fittings.

From the first floor you enjoy a lovely sense of openness and privacy, and the south-west-facing balcony is a real bonus, and as it's covered, it's a space you can enjoy throughout the year.

The bedroom is equally impressive, with built-in storage and the same finish found throughout the home. The bathroom continues the contemporary feel, with striking black fittings, a wall-recessed toilet and a shower over the generous bath.
